PARKING LOT RADIO MASS: All weekend Masses at Good Shepherd Church (Saturday 6:00 PM, Sunday 8:00 AM and 9:30 AM) will be available over your car radio. We ask that you park in the lower lot (to the left of the



church) and tune your car radio to FM 98.3. You will be able to listen to the Mass over your radio in the comfort of your car and remain socially distant. At the end of Mass an Extraordinary Minister will come to the parking lot to distribute Holy Communion. If you bring your envelops, they will also be collected. Spread the word!

BLESSING OF THROATS will take place during next weekend's masses (January 30th and 31st and also Wednesday, February 3rd). The Diocese has issued guidelines for the blessing of throats this year. We will not be blessing individual throats because of the social distancing situation with the Covid-19 virus. At the end of mass before the distribution of communion a general blessing of the throats will be given from the altar.
