


Message from Father Mike...

This past Ash Wednesday you received a wood coin imprinted with four different words: Abstinence, Almsgiving, Fasting and Prayer. During the next four weeks we will focus on each one of these words.

ABSTIENENCE: Many of us will Abstain from something during the Lenten Season. As children we probably gave up candy, sugar and sweets. We Kloton Kids gave up ice cream – ironically, because ice cream was expensive, we rarely got it.

This Lent you are encouraged to move from candy, sugar and sweets to abstaining from hate, gossip and slander. Lent is a time for us to make important changes in our lives. This first week, you are encouraged to do a little self-searching and practice appropriate Abstinence.
