

This weekend's banner reads: **FASTING**. The Catholic Church defines Fasting as: "The reduction of one's intake of food." There are technically two days during the Lenten Season we are mandated to Fast: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. I am sure many of you are fasting from certain foods like candy, alcohol and deserts (our favorite goodies). This is good for the body and hopefully for the soul.
