Message from Father Mike...

In this weekend's Gospel Jesus raised his friend Lazarus from the dead. Lazarus was in the tomb for three days, he was confined by death and the grave. Jesus called to him, and he came out of the tomb alive to the amazement of all around him.

There are many people in tombs today. Some are held in tombs beyond their control, while others enter into tombs on their own. And whatever your ailment, disability, relationship status, addiction, mental illness, etc., Jesus is calling you from that tomb. Jesus want you to be alive again.

You have two challenges this week: if you know someone in a tomb, do what you can to help bring them out. Secondly, if you are in the tomb, and want to come out turn to Jesus, and he will show you the way. Jesus loved his friend Lazarus and did not want him to be in the tomb. Jesus loves you and is calling you for us from the tomb.
