

It has been one week since we celebrated Easter Sunday – the Resurrection of Jesus. The pews were filled. Folks knew they had to go church. This weekend the pews are not as full. Where are they?

In this weekend's Gospel, Jesus appears to the Apostles in the Upper Room. Thomas (Doubting Thomas) was not there – I wonder where he was? We do not know. We can ask the same question about those who are not in church this weekend.

Like Thomas, these folks appear to lack sufficient faith to carry them back to church. Thomas needed an encounter with Jesus (a week later, Thomas saw Jesus and believed). The folks who are not here this week also need an encounter with Jesus to bring them back to church. Here's your challenge: YOU become Jesus for them. We bring them back, not by chiding them, but through Mercy. On this Divine Mercy Sunday bring them back!
