Just 10 days ago, the Church commemorated Ascension Thursday -Jesus going to heaven after His resurrection. I want you to think about those 10 days. Jesus is gone. He did not leave a blueprint on how to run things. The first Gospel was not written until almost 30 years after His Ascension. Those days must have been tough for the disciples. They were still afraid of the Jews and other political leaders. They must have felt alone. Although Jesus promised the Holy Spirit, they had no idea who the Holy Spirit was and when the Spirit was coming. This image sets the stage for Pentecost. The Spirit DID come and It transformed the Apostles from timid men in hiding to powerful preachers of the

Word of God. We need to know the background to understand the importance of Pentecost. The disciples thought it was done and over. It was just the beginning! This is what the Holy Spirit did for the Apostles. What will the Holy Spirit do for you? Happy Birthday, Church!
