A Message from Father Mike...

Once a week in an old cast-iron skillet, I make an Irish soda bread. The ingredients are very simple: flour, sugar, salt, buttermilk and baking soda. It traditionally has the mark of the Cross on top. The priests and the staff seem to enjoy it.



Each week on the altar we also have a very special bread. Its ingredients are simple flour and water. There is a Cross on the top. What makes this bread so different are the special words of institution said by the priest on the altar. It is transformed from bread to the Body of Christ.

This weekend the church celebrates the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. As you approach the altar to receive Jesus, know that it **REALLY IS** Him! Do you believe?



And stop by the rectory for a slice of Irish Soda Bread!
