Ralph was a young man I worked with many years ago at Scout Camp. He was a hard worker and loved being at camp. Ralph also had an addiction issue. We did not know it at the time. His use of drugs led him down a very dark road and he ended up in prison. Fast forward some 30 years and I am working as a prison chaplain. You guessed it! Ralph was an inmate. He told his story of how he ended up incarcerated. But he also told the story of how prison saved his life. Ralph had a monkey on his back he could not shake off. After being sentenced and given 20-to-30 years for his crime, he was at a cross roads: either get

help or die. He got help in a recovery program at the prison. Ralph replaced the monkey on his back with the Cross of Christ on his shoulder. Prison is not easy for him and he has hard time to do. But he awakes each day knowing that he will get through because he has chosen the Cross of Christ rather an addiction. How will you carry the Cross of Christ this week?
