Masses for this Feast Day are the Vigil on Tuesday evening at 7:00 PM and mass for the Feast Day on Wednesday morning at 7:00 AM. Please note that the regular 7:00 AM mass on Tuesday **DOES NOT** satisfy your obligation for the Holy Day of Obligation. You **must** attend either the 7:00 PM mass on Tuesday or the 7:00 AM mass on Wednesday.
