Last weekend's Gospel focused on Faith, specifically Peter's lack of Faith. This weekend's Gospel again focuses on Faith, but from a different perspective. A Canaanite women came to Jesus and asked Him to heal her daughter. Because she was a foreigner and a woman, Jesus should neither have even listened to her nor healed her daughter. There was, however, the element of Faith. Unlike Peter, who

showed little Faith, this woman showed great Faith. This Faith in Jesus came from a most unlikely place. We have the Apostle of Jesus, who should have been filled with faith up against a woman who should have had little Faith. Think about the times in your life when you have been Peter and the times you have been the woman. Above all, have FAITH!,

HAVE YOU BEEN ASKED TO BE A SPONSOR FOR EITHER BAPTISM OR CONFIRMATION? It is an honor and a privilege to be chosen as a sponsor for either Baptism or Confirmation. Those who asked you to take on this solemn responsibility are looking to YOU to be a role model for the person receiving those sacraments.

The Roman Catholic Church has some basic criteria one must meet to be a sponsor:

- 1. You <u>must be</u> registered in the parish. This means that you have <u>your own</u> registration and envelopes, not your parents'.
- 2. You must attend Church on a regular basis. If you are attending Mass on a regular basis, you are familiar with Father Mike, Father Rawel, and Deacon Jim, and they are familiar with you.

If you do not fit the above two criteria, we are unable to issue the document saying you are a *PRACTICING CATHOLIC*. This is the teachable moment. If you want to be a sponsor and are not active in the church, there is still time for you. Make an appointment with the pastor to talk about the situation. The door is always open!

PARENTS: Make sure the Godparents you choose are able to meet these two very important criteria. Being a Godparent is not just an honorary title. It is a commitment to the faith formation of your child.
