

This weekend's Gospel focuses on mercy. Folks were hired to go into the vineyard at various times of the day. At sunset all were brought in and given the same amount of pay, even those who worked only a few hours. I think we get the "mercy" side of the story. The real story-behind-the-story is the group who worked all day. They were angry and complained, thinking they should get more. They were thinking as humans do and not as God does.

Let's look at it a different way. As a priest I am often called to administer the Sacrament of the Sick to those very near death. Some of these folks have not been to church since Confirmation. This is a grace-filled moment of mercy. God is not saying: "Nope, you haven't been to church," but rather: "Welcome back to the church." His mercy is open to all.
