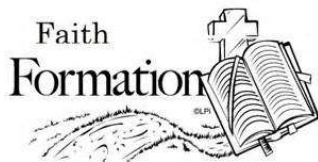
**SECOND COLLECTION** next weekend is for the Care and Education of Priests.
