This weekend's readings appear to talk about divorce. The Pharisees challenge Jesus saying that Moses allowed for divorce. The issue here was not divorce, but rather the Jewish leaders trying to trip Jesus up. They saw Jesus as a threat. They failed to see Jesus for who He really was: The Son of God. There are times in our lives when we feel threatened by others and their views and way

of life. Many immediately put up a wall of defense and fail to listen, truly listen <u>to the other</u> <u>person.</u>

The ironic thing about this encounter between Jesus and the Jewish leaders was that HE was not a threat. Jesus wanted to embrace the leaders and show them a better way, but they would not because of their hardened hearts and blind eyes. Our challenge this week is to see Jesus in others.
