"A voice crying in the wilderness, prepare the way of the Lord." I can remember as a child preparing for Christmas. We didn't know it at the time, but we were From the Pastor poor. There was always food on the table, and I learned to like liver & onions, chicken gizzards and cow tongue (all foods that were inexpensive). Right after **Thanksgiving** 

we began to cut boughs of ferns from the tall pine trees around our house. We took them to the basement (the basement still had a dirt floor). Mom and dad would transform those boughs of ferns into beautiful sprays for the front door. We took pine cones and sprayed them different colors. These sprays were not for our front door. We sold them. I was told we needed to do this to make Christmas nice for others. In reality, my parents needed the money to buy us gifts. How I miss those times. I long for the voice of my parents crying out in the wilderness: Prepare the way of the Lord!


