A VIEW FROM THE PEW, A FEW WORDS ON ADVENT

Advent is often swallowed by the commercialization of Christmas. I know that's a worn-out phrase, but we often forget that like Lent this is also a time of spiritual preparation, a journey. The first candle on the wreath is lit and we are to PREPARE for the birth of Christ. How are we to accomplish such a goal, through FORGIVENESS. Not only by asking God for forgiveness, but we must also forgive others, have mercy. When the second candle is lit maybe it's a good time to let go of our anger and grudges. The third week of Advent is marked by a rose-colored candle.
